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M O T I O N S

Organisation

1. That a Book of Rules be printed and be made available to Adjudicators, Teachers and Parents.
2. No Member of An Comdhail should write to any other Body than An Comdhail with complaints.

An Commission Le Rinci Gaelacha

1. That An Comdhail refuse to accept the Constitution of the Commission as it stands.
2. Under present circumstances a Vote of No Confidence should be passed on the Commission.
3. It is proposed that Ceilidhe Dance Books (An Rinci Foirne) be printed in Irish.
4. A general discussion on the All-Ireland Championships.
5. An Comdhail's Relationship with the Irish Dancing Commission - both North and South.
6. Are Rules passed at the Convention being upheld by the Local Branches?
7. Teachers and Adjudicators list should be issued yearly by An Comdhail. (Belfast)
8. Ulster Commission - clarification of An Comdhail action. (Belfast)
9. Western Feiseanna - accepting Entries from Non-Registered Teachers - should Registered Adjudicator act at such Feiseanna? (Belfast)
10. The Convention should be held on the last Weekend in August. (Belfast)
11. An Unregistered Teacher organising a Feis for the past 17 years, at which his pupils compete and are adjudicated by a Registered Adjudicator - is this permissible? (Galway)
12. What should be the reaction of a Member of An Comdhail should another teacher violate the Transfer Rule of 1st January? (Galway)
13. What is the position of the Ulster Teacher with regards to the Ulster Championships normally held in October, and what is the position of Feiseanna wishing to register in the future. (Derry)
14. At a recent Public Meeting in Derry, a Member of the former Ulster Commission stated that with regards to Strabane Feis in November, if for any reason a Teacher was not entering her pupils, the Parents should enter the pupils themselves. Would An Comdhail inform all Feis Committees re position of Teachers on this point. (Derry)
