

SUMMARY OF DECISIONS TAKEN AT THE 1964
CONVENTION OF IRISH DANCING TEACHERS AND
ADJUDICATORS

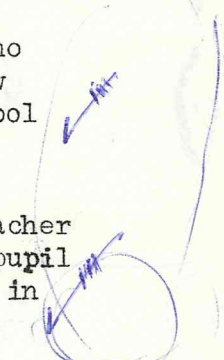
North Coast Hotel, Co. Dublin.

1. That the Irish Dancing Commission be requested to abolish temporary Registration not later than six months from the date of the Convention.
2. Endorsement of Commission Rule of six months suspension no matter what the cause of transfer and irrespective of how long it may have been since last tuition at previous school of dancing.
3. In cases of dancing incorrectly as to age or grade, a teacher must compose a suspension of three months on his or her pupil on being notified by the Association having jurisdiction in that area.
4. Age as at the 1st January would decide eligibility for competitions in the various age groups.
5. Commission Rule on the prohibition of reinforcement of shoes was endorsed.
6. On the question of Standardisation of figure dancing it was agreed to abide by Ar Rinne Foirne Cuid I and Cuid II excepting the few inaccuracies in the printed text of some of the dances.
7. The definition of an N. P. W. as set out in the rules of The Dublin Association was accepted by the Convention with the following addendum:

"that a dancer, having won a first or second prize for a specific dance in a particular age group, could not compete in an N. P. W. Competition for the same dance in a lower age group notwithstanding qualification as to age".

Where a prize is won for a dance from part of a group of dances as for example - a Cup or Championship the winner of a first or second for any of it shall be recognised in the group of
